





Execution of electricity sale agreements directly between electricity producers and end users, with electricity delivered to end uses through the power grid (Third Party Access: TPA).



### Target end users -

Data Center companies that want to use renewable energy electricity as required by their parent companies. Their operations necessitate standardized approaches in all countries where they invest, i.e. being large-scale and new investments.

### **Trading Method**

Electricity is sold directly to end users, via a request for access to TPA services, without selling electricity back into the national grid or back to the government. TPA charge must correspond with the UGT.




## **Participating power plants**

- New RE power plants.
- Existing RE power plants, having no PPAs with the Electricity Utilities.
- RE sources used for electricity generation are solar and wind, probably combined with an energy storage system.
