

Notification of the Office of the Energy Regulatory Commission on No Gift Policy, for Fiscal Year B.E. 2568 (2025)

According to the Cabinet resolution approving the National Reform Plan (Revised Version) pertaining to Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Malfeasance, by setting forth crucial reform activities, the Activity No. 4: Developing Thai Government Bureaucracy System with Transparency and Free from Benefits, Goal 1, Clause 1.1, stipulates that each individual state agency shall declare itself as an agency in which all state officials do not accept any kind of gifts and gratuities from their duty execution (No Gift Policy).

In order to express a strong intention to oppose all forms of corruption and malfeasance and to reinforce the culture of integrity in performing duties, which will bring about transparency in the operations of the personnel in the agency in accordance with the good governance principles and will enhance mobilization of the Thai government bureaucracy system to be transparent and free from benefits to achieve impartial performance, the Office of the Energy Regulatory Commission, hereby, issues this notification for all executives, officials and personnel to strictly observe the following:

- 1. Must not accept gifts and gratuities of any kind while performing duties, before performing duties and after performing duties, which could result in corruption and malfeasance both at present and in the future.
- 2. Must not give and seek gifts and gratuities of any kind to/from external individuals or entities while performing duties.
- 3. Must not act or refrain from any acts so as to acquire gifts, gratuities, property or any other benefits, considered to be illegitimate.
- 4. Acceptance of property or any other benefits in an ethical manner shall comply with the Notification of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on Criteria for Acceptance of Property or Any Other Benefits on an Ethical Basis by State Officials B.E. 2563 (2020).
